10	Section l. A new section of Chapter 35 NMSA 1978 is
11	enacted to read:
12	"MAGISTRATE COURTS OPERATIONS FUNDCREATEDPURPOSE
13	TERMINATION OF FUNDThe "magistrate courts operations fund"
14	is created in the state treasury for appropriation by the
15	legislature for the operations of magistrate courts. The
16	fund consists of magistrate courts operations fees collected
17	pursuant to Section 66-8-116.3 NMSA 1978 and any
18	appropriations, gifts, grants and donations. Income from the
19	fund shall be credited to the fund. Money in the fund at the
20	end of fiscal years 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 shall not
21	revert to any other fund. Balances remaining in the fund at
22	the end of fiscal year 2014 shall revert to the general fund,
23	and the fund shall be dissolved on July 1, 2014."
