A MEMORIAL

DECLARING JANUARY 27, 2010 "FARM AND RANCH WORKERS AND FAMILIES DAY" AT THE SENATE.

WHEREAS, agriculture's contribution to New Mexico's heritage and economic health is well-known; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico is ranked sixth in the nation in the exportation of dairy products, the state's number one agricultural commodity; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico is ranked thirteenth in the nation in cattle production, our number two commodity; and

WHEREAS, according to United States department of agriculture rankings, only California had greater chile production than New Mexico, and New Mexicans know that no place grows better chile than New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, the New Mexico farm and ranch community paid an estimated one hundred forty-nine million three hundred seventy thousand three hundred dollars (\$149,370,300) in taxes; and

WHEREAS, major farm and ranch production in New Mexico includes cattle, sheep and wool, dairy products, alfalfa and other hays, wheat, sorghum, cotton, chile, pecans, lettuce, corn and onions; and

WHEREAS, the production of many of these commodities would not be possible without the approximately twelve

1	thousand farm and ranch workers in New Mexico; and	
2	WHEREAS, farm and ranch workers in New Mexico have been	
3	tending crops and livestock since the 1600s; and	
4	WHEREAS, for all of this time, farm and ranch workers	
5	have been the backbone of much of the farming and ranching	
6	industry; and	
7	WHEREAS, many farm and ranch workers receive little	
8	recognition for their work; and	
9	WHEREAS, all New Mexicans benefit from the labor of farm	
10	and ranch workers;	
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE	
12	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that January 27, 2010 be declared "Farm	
13	and Ranch Workers and Families Day" at the senate to honor	
14	the hardworking people whose role in New Mexico's economy is	
15	of great importance to all residents of the state; and	
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
