Senate Joint Memorial 36 requests RLD to develop a bill to provide for the regulation of the elevator industry to provide adequate protection for the public.

The results of this effort must be reported to the appropriate interim legislative committee by December 1, 2010.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no fiscal impact.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Building codes provide for the installation of elevators to provide for the safety of the public.

Continuing safe operations and maintenance of elevators are not provided for by state inspection.
