A MEMORIAL

ENCOURAGING ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL EXCHANGE WITH THE REPUBLIC OF GREECE.

WHEREAS, modern Greece traces its roots to the civilization of ancient Greece, generally considered to be the cradle of western civilization; and

WHEREAS, Greece is the birthplace of democracy, western philosophy, western literature and historiography, political science, major scientific and mathematical principles and western drama, including both tragedy and comedy; and

WHEREAS, Greece was the first area in Europe where advanced early civilizations emerged; and

WHEREAS, Greece has the tenth longest coastline in the world and features approximately one thousand four hundred islands, over two hundred of which are inhabited; and

1 WHEREAS, Greece was a founding member of the United
2 Nations; and

3 WHEREAS, the annual growth of Greek gross domestic product
4 has surpassed the respective levels of most of its European
5 Union partners; and

6 WHEREAS, Greek literature includes the monumental works of
7 Homer, Aeschylus, Sophocles and Euripides; and

8 WHEREAS, Greek cuisine is often cited as an example of the
9 healthy Mediterranean diet; and

10 WHEREAS, Greece, home to the first modern Olympics, holds
11 a long tradition in sports; and

12 WHEREAS, the Greek men's national soccer team won the
13 union of European football associations championship in 2004 in
14 one of the biggest surprises in the history of the sport; and

15 WHEREAS, the Greek men's national basketball team has a
16 decades-long tradition of excellence in the sport and is
17 currently ranked fourth in the world by the international
18 basketball federation;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
20 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the governor
21 be requested to encourage a significant and ongoing economic
22 and cultural exchange with Greece; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rich history and natural
24 beauty of Greece be recognized and applauded; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
