A MEMORIAL

DECLARING FEBRUARY 9, 2010 AS "4-H AND FFA DAY" AT THE SENATE.

WHEREAS, 4-H and FFA have been premier youth leadership organizations in New Mexico for more than eighty years; and

WHEREAS, 4-H and FFA sponsor chapters and clubs in rural and urban areas throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, more than ninety thousand youth between the ages of five and twenty-one years old participate in 4-H and FFA youth development programs statewide; and

WHEREAS, 4-H and FFA youth development programs are diverse and help participants acquire important life skills, including leadership, responsible citizenship, critical thinking, problem-solving, decision-making, conflict resolution and communication skills, that directly contribute to the successful transition of young people into productive adults;
