Bill Summary:

SM 57 requests that the interim Legislative Health and Human Services Committee establish a subcommittee to hear testimony and receive recommendations from agencies and entities knowledgeable about early childhood services, programs, and funding sources in order to identify opportunities for Native American communities to develop an infrastructure of early childhood programs and services. The memorial suggests that testimony be received from the:

- Children, Youth and Families Department;
- Children's Cabinet;
- Indian Affairs Department;
- Office of School and Adolescent Health at the Department of Health;
- Public Education Department;
- New Mexico Voices for Children; and
- Early Childhood Action Network.
