## **Bill Summary:**

SM 70 requests that the Legislative Education Study Committee (LESC) study:

- the law and the public school funding formula calculations for small school size adjustment and rural isolation units; and
- the need for a hold-harmless provision to minimize drastic fluctuations in funding for the Gallup-McKinley County school district.

The memorial further requests:

- that the LESC report its findings and recommendations to the appropriate interim legislative committee by December 1, 2011; and
- that copies of the memorial be transmitted to the director of the LESC, the Public Education Department, and the Gallup- McKinley County school district.
