11	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; DEFINING "MOTOR SCOOTER"; PROVIDING
12	FOR OPERATION OF MOTOR SCOOTERS.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. Section 66-1-4.11 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1990,
16	Chapter 120, Section 12, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"66-1-4.11. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Motor Vehicle
18	Code:
19	A. "mail" means any item properly addressed with
20	postage prepaid delivered by the United States postal service
21	or any other public or private enterprise primarily engaged in
22	the transport and delivery of letters, packages and other
23	parcels;
24	B. "manufactured home" means a movable or portable
25	housing structure that exceeds either a width of eight feet or

C. "manufacturer" means every person engaged in the business of constructing or assembling vehicles of a type required to be registered under the Motor Vehicle Code;

D. "manufacturer's certificate of origin" means a certification, on a form supplied by or approved by the department, signed by the manufacturer that the new vehicle or boat described in the certificate has been transferred to the New Mexico dealer or distributor named in the certificate or to a dealer duly licensed or recognized as such in another state, territory or possession of the United States and that such transfer is the first transfer of the vehicle or boat in ordinary trade and commerce;

E. "moped" means a two-wheeled or three-wheeled vehicle with an automatic transmission and a motor having a piston displacement of less than fifty cubic centimeters, that is capable of propelling the vehicle at a maximum speed of not more than thirty miles an hour on level ground, at sea level;

F. "motorcycle" means every motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact with the ground, excluding a tractor;

G. "motor home" means a camping body built on a .183569.3

1 self-propelled motor vehicle chassis so designed that seating 2 for driver and passengers is within the body itself;

3 <u>H. "motor scooter" means a two- or three-wheeled</u>
4 <u>vehicle that has a seat or saddle for the use of the rider, an</u>
5 <u>automatic transmission and a piston displacement of no less</u>
6 <u>than fifty cubic centimeters and no more than one hundred fifty</u>
7 <u>cubic centimeters;</u>

8 [H+] <u>I.</u> "motor vehicle" means every vehicle that is

10 power obtained from batteries or from overhead trolley wires,
11 but not operated upon rails; but for the purposes of the

[I+] J. "motor vehicle insurance policy" means a policy of vehicle insurance that covers self-propelled vehicles of a kind required to be registered pursuant to New Mexico law for use on the public streets and highways. A "motor vehicle insurance policy":

(1) shall include:

(a) motor vehicle bodily injury and
 property damage liability coverages in compliance with the
 Mandatory Financial Responsibility Act; and

(b) uninsured motorist coverage, subject to the provisions of Section 66-5-301 NMSA 1978 permitting the insured to reject such coverage; and

6	SECTION 2. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is
7	enacted to read:
8	"[ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] MOTOR SCOOTERA person eighteen years of
9	age or older who has been issued a driver's license or a
10	commercial driver's license may operate a motor scooter without
11	the requirement of a motorcycle license or motorcycle
12	endorsement on the person's driver's license or commercial
13	driver's license. In all other respects, the provisions of the
14	Motor Vehicle Code that apply to the operation of a motorcycle
15	shall apply to the operation of a motor scooter."
16	SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
17	provisions of this act is July 1, 2011.
