15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. Section 10-11-130 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987,
17	Chapter 253, Section 130, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"10-11-130. RETIREMENT BOARDAUTHORITYMEMBERSHIP
19	A. The "retirement board" is created and is the
20	trustee of the association and the funds created by the state
21	retirement system acts and has all the powers necessary or
22	convenient to carry out and effectuate the purposes and
23	provisions of the state retirement system acts, including, in
24	addition to any specific powers provided for in the Public
25	Employees Retirement Act but without limiting the generality of

15 (4) adopt and use a seal for authentication of 16 records, processes and proceedings;

(5) create and maintain records relating to all members, affiliated public employers and all activities and duties required of the retirement board;

(6) issue subpoenas and compel the production of evidence and attendance of witnesses in connection with any hearings or proceedings of the retirement board;

(7) make and execute contracts;

(8) purchase, acquire or hold land adjacent to
the state capitol grounds or other suitable location and build

1 thereon a building to house the association and its employees 2 and, in the event additional office space is available in the 3 building after the retirement board and its employees have been housed, to rent or lease the additional space to any public 4 agency or private person; provided that first priority for the 5 rental or leasing shall be to public agencies and further 6 7 provided that for the purpose of purchasing, acquiring or 8 holding the land and the building thereon, the retirement board 9 may use funds from the income fund and any other funds controlled by the retirement board the use of which for such 10 purposes is not prohibited by law; 11

(9) after the sale of the land and building acquired pursuant to Paragraph (8) of this subsection, acquire land and build thereon a new building to house the association and its employees and hold the building and land in fee simple in the name of the association. In order to acquire the land and plan, design and construct the building, the retirement board may expend the proceeds of the sale of the land and building acquired pursuant to Paragraph (8) of this subsection or any funds controlled by the board, the use of which for such purposes is not otherwise prohibited by law;

(10) make and adopt such reasonable rules as may be necessary or convenient to carry out the duties of the retirement board and activities of the association, including any rules necessary to preserve the status of the association

1 as a qualified pension plan under the provisions of the 2 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or under successor or related provisions of law; and 3 designate committees and designate 4 (11)5 committee members, including individuals who may not be members of the association. 6 7 Β. The retirement board consists of: (1)the secretary of state; 8 9 (2) the state treasurer; four members under a state coverage plan 10 (3) to be elected by the members under state coverage plans; 11 12 (4) four members under a municipal coverage plan to be elected by the members under municipal coverage 13 14 plans, provided one member shall be a municipal member employed by a county; and 15 (5) two retired members to be elected by the 16 retired members of the association. 17 The results of elections of elected members of C. 18 19 the retirement board shall be certified at the annual meeting 20 of the association. Elections shall be conducted according to rules the retirement board adopts from time to time. 21 D. The regular term of office of the elected 22 members of the retirement board is four years. under a municipal coverage plan expire on December 31 of noncoinciding years in the pattern set by the retirement board. Members of the retirement board serve until their successors have qualified.

E. A member elected to the retirement board who fails to attend four consecutively scheduled meetings of the retirement board, unless in each case excused for cause by the retirement board members in attendance, is considered to have resigned from the retirement board, and the retirement board shall by resolution declare the office vacated as of the date of adoption of the resolution. A vacancy occurring on the retirement board, except in the case of an elected official, shall be filled by the remaining retirement board members, without requirement that a quorum be present. The member appointed to fill the vacancy serves for the remainder of the vacated term.

F. Members of the retirement board serve without salary for their services as retirement board members, but they shall receive those amounts authorized under the Per Diem and Mileage Act.

G. The retirement board shall hold four regular meetings each year and shall designate in advance the time and place of the meetings. Special meetings and emergency meetings of the retirement board may be held upon call of the [chairman] chair or any three members of the retirement board. Written .183747.1

1 notice of special meetings shall be sent to each member of the 2 retirement board at least seventy-two hours in advance of the special meeting. Verbal notice of emergency meetings shall be 3 given to as many members as is feasible at least eight hours 4 before the emergency meeting, and the meeting shall commence 5 with a statement of the nature of the emergency. 6 The 7 retirement board shall adopt its own rules of procedure and 8 shall keep a record of its proceedings. All meetings of the 9 retirement board shall comply with the Open Meetings Act. A majority of retirement board members shall constitute a quorum. 10 Each attending member of the retirement board is entitled to 11 12 one vote on each question before the retirement board, and at least a majority of a quorum shall be necessary for a decision 13 14 by the retirement board.

H. Annual meetings of the members of the association shall be held in Santa Fe at such time and place as the retirement board shall from time to time determine. Special meetings of the members of the association shall be held in Santa Fe upon call of any seven retirement board members. The retirement board shall send a written notice to the last known residence address of each member currently employed by an affiliated public employer at least ten days prior to any meeting of the members of the association. The notice shall contain the call of the meeting and the principal purpose of the meeting. All meetings of the association shall .183747.1

be public and shall be conducted according to procedures the retirement board shall from time to time adopt. The retirement board shall keep a record of the proceedings of each meeting of the association.

Τ. Neither the retirement board nor the association 5 shall allow public inspection of, or disclosure of, information 6 7 from any member or retiree file unless a prior release and 8 consent, in the form prescribed by the association, has been 9 executed by the member or retiree; except that applicable coverage plans, amounts of retirement plan contributions made 10 by members and affiliated public employers, pension amounts 11 12 paid and the names and addresses of public employees retirement association members or retirees requested for election purposes 13 by candidates for election to the retirement board may be 14 produced or disclosed without release or consent. 15

J. The retirement board shall provide actuarial and other solvency-related reports to the legislature and to interim committees of the legislature upon request of the legislature or an interim committee."
