SECTION 6. CONTINGENT ENACTMENT AND EFFECTIVE DATE.--

- A. If any law is enacted by the fiftieth legislature in the first session of 2011 that increases the age and service requirements in Sections 10-11-87, 10-11-93, 10-11-99, 10-11-105 or 10-11-111 NMSA 1978 to require a minimum of twenty-five or more years of service, this act shall not take effect.
- B. Subject to Subsection A of this section, the effective date of this act is July 1, 2011.
