I request that the following be funded:

- to the department of environment

NW NM RGNL SOLID WASTE AUTH WALKING FLOOR TRAILERS

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to purchase and equip walking floor trailers and trucks for the northwest New Mexico regional solid waste authority in Thoreau in McKinley county

- to the Indian affairs department

TSAYATOH CHP POWERLINE EXTEND

forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) for powerline extensions in the Tsayatoh chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TWIN LAKES CHAPTER ELECTRIC TRANSFORMER

thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for an electric transformer for the new government complex in the Twin Lakes chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

ROCK SPRINGS CHP VETERANS HALL SITE & CONSTRUCT

forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) to plan, design, construct and prepare the site for the veterans hall in the Rock Springs chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

GALLUP INDIAN MEDICAL CENTER LAND & CONSTRUCT

seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) to purchase land for and to plan, design and construct the Gallup Indian medical center in McKinley county

MCKINLEY CO RD 1 IMPROVE

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including chip sealing, widening and drainage, to county road 1 in McKinley county

ALLISON RD CORRIDOR IMPROVE DESIGN-GALLUP

five hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$560,000) to design Allison road corridor improvements, including bridge replacement, environmental clearances, right-of-way planning and acquisition and preliminary corridor design, in Gallup in McKinley county

GALLUP ANGLED PARKING ON NM HWY 118

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct angled parking on New Mexico highway 118 in downtown Gallup in McKinley county

MEXICAN SPRINGS CHP RURAL ROAD NETWORK

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design, construct and improve a rural road network, with focus on Deer Springs road, in the Mexican Springs chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

RED LAKE CHP ROAD TO HEAD START IMPROVE

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design, construct and improve the road to the head start facility and the rural road network in the Red Lake chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TWIN LAKES CHP RURAL ROAD NETWORK

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design, construct and improve a rural road network, with focus on Johnson road, in the Twin Lakes chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TWO GREY HILLS CHP RURAL ROAD NETWORK

forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) to plan, design, construct and improve a rural road network in the Two Grey Hills chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county
