F. "public records" means all documents, papers, letters, books, maps, tapes, photographs, recordings and other materials, regardless of physical form or characteristics, that are used, created, received, maintained or held by or on behalf of any public body and relate to public business, whether or not the records are required by law to be created or maintained."

SECTION 2. Section 14-2-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 258, Section 6) is amended to read:

"14-2-9. PROCEDURE FOR INSPECTION.--

Requested public records containing information 13 Α. that is exempt and nonexempt from disclosure shall be 14 15 separated by the custodian prior to inspection, and the nonexempt information shall be made available for inspection. 16 If necessary to preserve the integrity of computer data or 17 the confidentiality of exempt information contained in a 18 database, a partial printout of data containing public 19 20 records or information may be furnished in lieu of an entire database. Exempt information in an electronic document shall 21 be removed along with the corresponding metadata prior to 22 disclosure by utilizing methods or redaction tools that 23 prevent the recovery of exempt information from a redacted 24 electronic document. 25

1 B. A custodian shall provide a copy of a public 2 record in electronic format if the public record is available 3 in electronic format and an electronic copy is specifically requested. However, a custodian is only required to provide 4 5 the electronic record in the file format in which it exists 6 at the time of the request. C. A custodian: 7 (1) may charge reasonable fees for copying 8 the public records, unless a different fee is otherwise 9 prescribed by law; 10 (2) shall not charge fees in excess of one 11 dollar (\$1.00) per printed page for documents eleven inches 12 by seventeen inches in size or smaller; 13 (3) may charge the actual costs associated 14 15 with downloading copies of public records to a computer disk or storage device, including the actual cost of the computer 16 disk or storage device; 17 (4) may charge the actual costs associated 18 with transmitting copies of public records by mail, 19 20 electronic mail or facsimile; may require advance payment of the fees (5)21 before making copies of public records; 22 (6) shall not charge a fee for the cost of 23 determining whether any public record is subject to 24 disclosure; and 25
