BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSACTION FEES; ALLOWING STATE AGENCIES AND

LOCAL GOVERNING BODIES TO CHARGE A UNIFORM FEE TO PERSONS

MAKING PAYMENTS BY CREDIT CARD OR ELECTRONIC TRANSFER.

SECTION 1. Section 6-10-1.2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1999, Chapter 176, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"6-10-1.2. PAYMENT METHODS AUTHORIZED--FEE.--

A. A state agency or local governing body may 10 accept payment by credit card or electronic means of any 11 amount due under any law or program administered by the 12 agency or local governing body. The state board of finance 13 shall adopt rules on the terms and conditions of a state 14 15 agency accepting payments by credit card or electronic The local governing body shall adopt procedures, 16 transfer. subject to the approval of the department, on the terms and 17 conditions of accepting payments by credit card or electronic 18 transfer. 19

B. A state agency or local governing body may
charge a uniform convenience fee to cover the approximate
costs imposed by a financial institution that are directly
related to processing a credit card or electronic transfer
transaction. The fee shall be charged to the person using a
credit card or electronic transfer. Amounts collected
