2	DECLARING MARCH 2, 2011 "LAS ESPERANZAS DAY" IN THE SENATE.

4	WHEREAS, Las Esperanzas, incorporated, is a neighborhood
5	nonprofit organization whose mission is to facilitate the
6	preservation, revitalization and protection of the Mesquite
7	street-original townsite historic district; and
8	WHEREAS, before it was a street, Mesquite street was
9	part of El Camino Real; and
10	WHEREAS, in 1847, Pablo Melendrez used a rawhide rope to
11	lay out a grid that would become Las Cruces; and
12	WHEREAS, the grid was thirteen blocks long and six
13	blocks wide and was divided among the settling families,
14	whose decendants still live in the historic district; and
15	WHEREAS, with the assistance of the New Mexico
16	legislature and countless volunteers, the historic district
17	now has Jardin de Mesquite park, Jardin de Esperanzas
18	community garden, Entrada del Sol park and a refurbished
19	Klein park; and
20	WHEREAS, the neighborhood is now adorned with decorative
21	light fixtures with historic medallions; and
22	WHEREAS, working in partnership with CARTA, the historic
23	district has had its history returned to it and was recently
24	designated by the national trails system as part of the El
25	Camino Real de Tierra Adentro;
