Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 384 extends for one year, through the 2013-2014 school years, the authority for the PED Secretary to waive specified requirements of the Public School Code and associated rules.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

House Bill 384 contains no appropriation and has no fiscal implications for the state. Local School Districts would potentially realize cost reductions should the PED Secretary waive requirements under the Public School Code.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The PED Secretary would be authorized to waive requirements pertaining to individual class load, teaching load, length of school day, staffing patterns, subject areas and purchases of instructional materials.
