#### Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 41 requests that the state's higher education institutions participate in various roles in a study of the impact of increased use of natural gas as a transportation fuel.

The proposed memorial includes citations on the current use and availability of natural gas as a transportation fuel, and the potential benefits to the New Mexico economy as well as the nation's energy security as a result of increasing its use. A potential favorable environmental impact from lowered greenhouse gas and particulate emissions is also mentioned.

The memorial proposes a convergent effort for reporting by the state's higher education institutions on the issues associated with increased use of natural gas as a transportation fuel.

- The UNM Law School would be requested to report on the potential liability and litigation issues.
- The Arrowhead Center at New Mexico State University would be requested to report on infrastructure issues.
- Eastern New Mexico University, Western New Mexico University and New Mexico Highlands University would be asked to offer suggestions on how to facilitate its use

• The memorial directs that the reports be submitted to the appropriate interim legislative committees by November 1, 2011.
