SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 8 proposes to amend the Condominium Act to require confirmation from the local zoning official that a condominium declaration complies with local zoning and subdivision laws.

TECHNICAL ISSUES

The AGO submits that:

"the phrase 'as required in Section 47-7A-6 NMSA 1978' is unclear since Section 47-7A-6 does not require anything, it just clarifies how the law should be read."

WHAT WILL BE THE CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ENACTING THIS BILL

There will be no requirement that condominium declarations meet local zoning and subdivision laws.
