50TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2011

AN ACT

RELATING TO EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC MONEY; REAUTHORIZING OR REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING OR CHANGING PURPOSES, EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CHANGING AGENCIES AND ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE LEGISLATURE IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund:

[bracketed material] = delete

1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period  
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed  
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not  
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in  
6 the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or  
7 the time frame set forth in any law that has previously  
8 reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is  
9 later; and

10 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds  
11 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been  
12 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax  
13 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the  
14 unexpended balances.

15 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding  
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--  
20 REVERSIONS.--

21 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section  
22 of this act:

23 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation  
24 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed  
25 in this act shall revert:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period  
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed  
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not  
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in  
6 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the  
7 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed the  
8 appropriation, whichever is later; and

9 (2) all remaining balances of an appropriation  
10 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed  
11 in this act shall revert three months after the reversion date  
12 for the unexpended balance.

13 B. Except as provided in Subsection D of this  
14 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general  
15 fund shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to  
16 the capital projects fund.

17 C. Except as provided in Subsection D of this  
18 section, the balance of an appropriation made from other state  
19 funds shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to  
20 the originating fund.

21 D. The balance of an appropriation made from the  
22 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs  
23 department or the aging and long-term services department for a  
24 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo  
25 shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to the

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1 tribal infrastructure project fund.

2 E. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
3 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
4 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding  
5 written obligations to third parties.

6 SECTION 3. FISHER AND SMITH MEMORIAL GYMNASIUM AT VISTA  
7 GRANDE COMMUNITY CENTER--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE  
8 TAX BONDS.--The local government division project in Subsection  
9 1 of Section 23 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 to plan, design and  
10 construct the Fisher and Smith memorial gymnasium at the Vista  
11 Grande community center in Bernalillo county may include  
12 equipping and furnishing that center. The time of expenditure  
13 is extended through fiscal year 2013.

14 SECTION 4. CHRISTINE DUNCAN COMMUNITY SCHOOL--CHANGE TO  
15 AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMING ARTS CENTER--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND  
16 TIME--GENERAL FUND.--Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) of the  
17 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the public education  
18 department in Subsection 52 of Section 55 of Chapter 42 of Laws  
19 2007 for a facility for Christine Duncan community school in  
20 the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county  
21 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is  
22 appropriated to the state fair commission to construct and  
23 equip the multipurpose room at the African American performing  
24 arts center on the state fairgrounds in Albuquerque. The time  
25 of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2013.

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1           SECTION 5. HILAND THEATER CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION--  
 2 CHANGE TO AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMING ARTS CENTER MULTIPURPOSE  
 3 ROOM--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--Ninety-two  
 4 thousand nine hundred twenty-seven dollars (\$92,927) of the  
 5 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government  
 6 division in Subsection 14 of Section 68 of Chapter 42 of Laws  
 7 2007 to construct and renovate the Hiland theater in  
 8 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the  
 9 original purpose but is appropriated to the state fair  
 10 commission to construct and equip the multipurpose room at the  
 11 African American performing arts center at the state  
 12 fairgrounds in Albuquerque. The time of expenditure is  
 13 extended through fiscal year 2013.

14           SECTION 6. ALBUQUERQUE BURTON PARK IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND  
 15 TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the local  
 16 government division project in Subsection 60 of Section 68 of  
 17 Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for improvements to Burton park in  
 18 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal  
 19 year 2013.

20           SECTION 7. ALAMOSA PARK RENOVATIONS--CHANGE TO TOWER  
 21 PARK--WEST GATE LITTLE LEAGUE IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL  
 22 FUND.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation originally  
 23 made in Subsection 14 of Section 52 of Chapter 347 of Laws 2005  
 24 and reappropriated in Laws 2007, Chapter 341, Section 20 to the  
 25 local government division to plan, design and renovate Alamosa

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1 park in Albuquerque shall not be expended for the original or  
2 reappropriated purpose but is changed to make improvements for  
3 Tower Park-West Gate little league in Albuquerque. The time of  
4 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2013.

5 **SECTION 8. YOUTH DIAGNOSTIC AND DEVELOPMENT CENTER**

6 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
7 expenditure for the capital program fund project in Subsection  
8 1 of Section 6 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for fire suppression  
9 improvements, roof repairs, upgrades to comply with the  
10 Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and kitchen and other  
11 renovations at the youth diagnostic and development center in  
12 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal  
13 year 2013.

14 **SECTION 9. CHRISTINE DUNCAN COMMUNITY SCHOOL--CHANGE TO**

15 BERNALILLO COUNTY SOUTH VALLEY POOL--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND  
16 TIME--GENERAL FUND.--Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) of the  
17 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the public education  
18 department in Subsection 52 of Section 55 of Chapter 42 of Laws  
19 2007 for a facility for Christine Duncan community school in  
20 the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county  
21 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is  
22 appropriated to the local government division to plan, design,  
23 equip, construct and redevelop the south valley pool facility  
24 and grounds in Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is  
25 extended through fiscal year 2013.

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1           **SECTION 10. ALBUQUERQUE DEAF CULTURE MULTIPURPOSE**

2           CENTER--EXPAND PURPOSE--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL  
 3           FUND.--The local government division project in Subsection 37  
 4           of Section 59 of Chapter 92 of Laws 2008 to purchase land for  
 5           and plan, design and construct a deaf culture multipurpose  
 6           center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county may include  
 7           purchasing, improving, renovating, furnishing and equipping a  
 8           building and is appropriated to the commission for deaf and  
 9           hard-of-hearing persons. The time of expenditure is extended  
 10          through fiscal year 2013.

11           **SECTION 11. CENTRAL-HIGHLAND UPPER NOB HILL REDEVELOPMENT**

12          AREA IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of  
 13          expenditure for the local government division project in  
 14          Subsection 122 of Section 68 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for  
 15          public infrastructure and street and streetscape improvements  
 16          to the Central-Highland upper Nob Hill redevelopment area in  
 17          Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal  
 18          year 2013.

19           **SECTION 12. LA PAZ AND PARADISE BOULEVARD TRAFFIC**

20          SIGNALS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure  
 21          for the department of transportation project in Subsection 62  
 22          of Section 75 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 to plan, design,  
 23          construct, purchase and install traffic signals at La Paz  
 24          boulevard and Paradise boulevard in Albuquerque in Bernalillo  
 25          county is extended through fiscal year 2013.

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1           **SECTION 13. HIGHLAND HIGH SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE, FACILITY**  
2           **AND SECURITY IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO CONSTRUCTING THE**  
3           **MULTIPURPOSE ROOM AT THE AFRICAN AMERICAN PERFORMING ARTS**  
4           **CENTER--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The**  
5           unexpended balance of the appropriation to the public education  
6           department in Subsection 108 of Section 55 of Chapter 42 of  
7           Laws 2007 for infrastructure, facility and security  
8           improvements at Highland high school in the Albuquerque public  
9           school district in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for  
10          the original purpose but is appropriated to the state fair  
11          commission to construct and equip the multipurpose room at the  
12          African American performing arts center on the state  
13          fairgrounds in Albuquerque. The time of expenditure is  
14          extended through fiscal year 2013.

15          **SECTION 14. STATE LABORATORY SERVICES BUILDING--EXTEND**  
16          **TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the capital**  
17          program fund project originally appropriated in Subsection 3 of  
18          Section 41 of Chapter 126 of Laws 2004 and reappropriated in  
19          Laws 2009, Chapter 128, Section 77 for a state laboratory  
20          services building in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is  
21          extended through fiscal year 2013.

22          **SECTION 15. HIGHLAND HIGH SCHOOL ON-SITE STREET VACATION**  
23          **INFRASTRUCTURE--CHANGE TO UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO CHEMISTRY**  
24          **BUILDING--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The**  
25          unexpended balance of the appropriation to the public education

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1 department made in Subsection 112 of Section 55 of Chapter 42  
 2 of Laws 2007 for on-site street vacation infrastructure at  
 3 Highland high school in the Albuquerque public school district  
 4 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is  
 5 appropriated to the board of regents of the university of New  
 6 Mexico to renovate the chemistry building at the university of  
 7 New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The time of  
 8 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2013.

9           **SECTION 16. HILAND THEATER RENOVATION--CHANGE TO**  
 10 **UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO CHEMISTRY BUILDING--CHANGE AGENCY--**  
 11 **EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**One hundred sixty thousand eight  
 12 hundred fifty-three dollars (\$160,853) of the unexpended  
 13 balance of the appropriation to the local government division  
 14 in Subsection 14 of Section 68 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for  
 15 renovating the Hiland theater in Albuquerque shall not be  
 16 expended for the original purpose but is appropriated to the  
 17 board of regents of the university of New Mexico to renovate  
 18 and repair the chemistry building at the university of New  
 19 Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The time of  
 20 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2013.

21           **SECTION 17. ALBUQUERQUE TRANSIT SYSTEM FEEDER ROUTE**  
 22 **IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO CHEMISTRY**  
 23 **BUILDING--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended balance of  
 24 the appropriation to the department of transportation in  
 25 Subsection 48 of Section 75 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for

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1 improvements to the transit system feeder routes in Albuquerque  
2 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is  
3 appropriated to the board of regents of the university of New  
4 Mexico to renovate the chemistry building at the university of  
5 New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The time of  
6 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2013.

7           **SECTION 18. GOLD AVENUE STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE**  
8 **TO UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO CHEMISTRY BUILDING--EXTEND TIME--**  
9 **GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended balance of the appropriation to  
10 the department of transportation in Subsection 53 of Section 75  
11 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for streetscape improvements on Gold  
12 avenue from Yale boulevard to Sycamore street in Albuquerque  
13 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is  
14 appropriated to the board of regents of the university of New  
15 Mexico to renovate the chemistry building at the university of  
16 New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The time of  
17 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2013.

18           **SECTION 19. ZUNI ROAD STREET LIGHTING--CHANGE TO**  
19 **UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO CHEMISTRY BUILDING--CHANGE AGENCY--**  
20 **EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended balance of the  
21 appropriation to the department of transportation in Subsection  
22 70 of Section 75 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for street lighting  
23 on Zuni road between Louisiana boulevard and Central avenue in  
24 Albuquerque shall not be expended for the original purpose but  
25 is appropriated to the board of regents of the university of

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1 New Mexico to renovate the chemistry building at the university  
2 of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The time of  
3 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2013.

4       **SECTION 20.** CHRISTINE DUNCAN COMMUNITY SCHOOL--CHANGE TO  
5 BOOK PURCHASE FOR SCHOOLS IN HOUSE DISTRICT 25 IN THE  
6 ALBUQUERQUE PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL  
7 FUND.--Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) of the unexpended balance  
8 of the appropriation to the public education department in  
9 Subsection 52 of Section 55 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for a  
10 facility for the Christine Duncan community school shall not be  
11 expended for the original purpose but is changed to purchase  
12 books and software to be divided equally among Jefferson and  
13 McKinley middle schools and Bel-Air, Hodgin and Montezuma  
14 elementary schools in the Albuquerque public school district in  
15 Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is extended through  
16 fiscal year 2013.

17       **SECTION 21.** CHRISTINE DUNCAN COMMUNITY SCHOOL--CHANGE TO  
18 WESTSIDE FOOTBALL STADIUM--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--Forty  
19 thousand dollars (\$40,000) of the unexpended balance of the  
20 appropriation to the public education department in Subsection  
21 52 of Section 55 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for a facility for  
22 Christine Duncan community school in the Albuquerque public  
23 school district in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for  
24 the original purpose but is changed to plan, design, construct  
25 and equip the westside football stadium in that school

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1 district. The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal  
2 year 2013.

3 SECTION 22. LA LUZ ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ELECTRICAL  
4 UPGRADES--CHANGE TO MISSION AVENUE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL  
5 INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The  
6 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the public education  
7 department in Subsection 140 of Section 55 of Chapter 42 of  
8 Laws 2007 for electrical upgrades at La Luz elementary school  
9 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is changed  
10 to purchase and install information technology, including  
11 related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Mission  
12 Avenue elementary school in the Albuquerque public school  
13 district in Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is  
14 extended through fiscal year 2013.

15 SECTION 23. ALBUQUERQUE GARFIELD PARK RECONSTRUCTION--  
16 CHANGE TO MISSION AVENUE ELEMENTARY INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY--  
17 CHANGE AGENCY--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance of the  
18 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 53  
19 of Section 59 of Chapter 92 of Laws 2008 to plan, design and  
20 reconstruct Garfield park in Albuquerque shall not be expended  
21 for the original purpose but is appropriated to the public  
22 education department to purchase and install information  
23 technology, including related equipment, furniture and  
24 infrastructure, at Mission Avenue elementary school in the  
25 Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county.

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1           **SECTION 24. ALBUQUERQUE RANCHO ENCANTADO PARK--CHANGE TO**  
2           MISSION AVENUE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SECURITY CAMERAS--CHANGE  
3           AGENCY--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance of the  
4           appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 87  
5           of Section 59 of Chapter 92 of Laws 2008 to plan and design  
6           Rancho Encantado park in Albuquerque shall not be expended for  
7           the original purpose but is appropriated to the public  
8           education department for security cameras at Mission Avenue  
9           elementary school in the Albuquerque public school district in  
10          Bernalillo county.

11          **SECTION 25. ROOSEVELT MIDDLE SCHOOL TRACK--EXTEND TIME--**  
12          GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the public education  
13          department project originally appropriated in Subsection 23 of  
14          Section 2 of Chapter 2 of Laws 2007 and reappropriated in  
15          Subsection B of Section 99 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 to plan,  
16          design and construct a track at Roosevelt middle school in the  
17          Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county is  
18          extended through fiscal year 2013.

19          **SECTION 26. WHITTIER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LANDSCAPING--**  
20          EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the  
21          public education department project in Subsection 271 of  
22          Section 55 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for landscaping at  
23          Whittier elementary school in the Albuquerque public school  
24          district in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year  
25          2013.

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1           **SECTION 27. SOUTHERN NEW MEXICO REHABILITATION CENTER--**  
2           **EXTEND TIME--REVENUE BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the  
3           revenue bond project originally authorized in Subsection C of  
4           Section 8 of Chapter 320 of Laws 2005 and reauthorized in  
5           Subsection 1 of Section 94 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for  
6           improvements at the southern New Mexico rehabilitation center  
7           is extended through fiscal year 2013.

8           **SECTION 28. THIRTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT ATTORNEY OFFICE**  
9           **RENOVATIONS--CHANGE TO CIBOLA COUNTY MOTOR GRADER PURCHASE--**  
10          **EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended balance of the  
11          appropriation to the local government division in Subsection  
12          239 of Section 68 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 for renovations  
13          and additions to the district attorney's office in the  
14          thirteenth judicial district in Cibola county shall not be  
15          expended for the original purpose but is changed to purchase  
16          and equip a motor grader for Cibola county. The time of  
17          expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2013.

18          **SECTION 29. CIBOLA COUNTY FACILITY RENOVATIONS--CHANGE TO**  
19          **MOTOR GRADER PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The  
20          unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government  
21          division in Subsection 242 of Section 68 of Chapter 42 of Laws  
22          2007 to plan, design, renovate and expand a facility in Cibola  
23          county shall not be expended for the original purpose but is  
24          changed to purchase and equip a motor grader for the road  
25          department in Cibola county. The time of expenditure is

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1 extended through fiscal year 2013.

2 **SECTION 30. CIBOLA COUNTY PLAZA AND COURTHOUSE**

3 IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO ROAD DEPARTMENT MOTOR GRADER--EXTEND

4 TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance of the

5 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection

6 159 of Section 59 of Chapter 92 of Laws 2008 for the plaza,

7 courthouse and courthouse complex in Grants in Cibola county

8 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is changed

9 to purchase and equip a motor grader for the Cibola county road

10 department. The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal

11 year 2013.

12 **SECTION 31. PUEBLO OF ACOMA SKYLINE LAGOON SYSTEM--EXTEND**

13 TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the Indian

14 affairs department project in Subsection 13 of Section 66 of

15 Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 to plan, design, construct and renovate

16 the skyline lagoon system at the Pueblo of Acoma in Cibola

17 county is extended through fiscal year 2013.

18 **SECTION 32. GRANTS WATER WELL--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL**

19 FUND.--The time of expenditure for the department of

20 environment project originally appropriated in Subsection 9 of

21 Section 45 of Chapter 111 of Laws 2006 and reappropriated in

22 Laws 2007, Chapter 341, Section 82 to drill and equip a water

23 well in Grants in Cibola county is extended through fiscal year

24 2013.

25 **SECTION 33. EAGLE NEST DAM AND RESERVOIR DIVERSION**

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1 STRUCTURES--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
2 expenditure for the office of the state engineer project in  
3 Subsection 1 of Section 15 of Chapter 42 of Laws 2007 to plan,  
4 design and renovate diversion structures below Eagle Nest dam  
5 and reservoir in Colfax county is extended through fiscal year  
6 2013.

7 SECTION 34. MINERS' COLFAX MEDICAL CENTER DISPENSING  
8 SYSTEM--CHANGE TO FLOORING--EXTEND TIME--MINERS' TRUST  
9 FUND.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation from the  
10 miners' trust fund to the miners' hospital in Laws 2009,  
11 Chapter 125, Section 44 to purchase and install a dispensing  
12 system shall not be expended for the original purpose but is  
13 changed to replace flooring at the long-term care facility at  
14 miners' hospital, also known as miners' Colfax medical center,  
15 in Raton in Colfax county. The time of expenditure is extended  
16 through fiscal year 2013.

17 SECTION 35. CLOVIS MOTOR VEHICLE DIVISION FIELD OFFICE  
18 IMPROVEMENTS--EXPAND PURPOSE TO INCLUDE RENOVATION,  
19 FURNISHINGS, INSTALLATION AND EQUIPMENT--SEVERANCE TAX  
20 BONDS.--The capital program fund project in Subsection 5 of  
21 Section 4 of Chapter 4 of Laws 2010 (2nd S.S.) for  
22 improvements, including mold remediation and structural and  
23 plumbing repairs, at the motor vehicle division's Clovis field

 20 PROJECTS--CHANGE AGENCY--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended  
 21 balance of the appropriation to the department of finance and  
 22 administration in Subsection 7 of Section 22 of Chapter 125 of  
 23 Laws 2009 for a solar equipment economic development project in  
 24 Belen in Valencia county pursuant to the Local Economic  
 25 Development Act shall not be expended for the original purpose

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1 but is appropriated to the economic development department for

9 renovate and equip a substance abuse treatment center in Los  
10 Lunas in Valencia county may include furnishings and  
11 installation at that facility.

12 SECTION 126. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
13 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
