CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR SENATOR STEPHEN H. FISCHMANN

I request that the following be funded:

- to the department of environment

SIERRA CO/T OR C RGNL WASTE TRANSFER STN LAND

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and acquire land for a regional solid waste transfer station in Truth or Consequences in Sierra county

SIERRA CO/T OR C SOLID WASTE CTR CONSTRUCT/EQUIP

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to construct and purchase and install equipment for the solid waste collection center in Truth or Consequences in Sierra county

SIERRA CO/T OR C TRANSFER STATION

one million six hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$1,675,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a joint transfer station for regional solid waste disposal in Truth or Consequences and Sierra county

- to the local government division of the department of finance and administration

MESILLA VALLEY 911 CENTER CONSTRUCT

eight hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$850,000) to purchase property for and to plan, design, construct, equip and install the Mesilla Valley regional dispatch authority emergency 911 center in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES EAST MESA PUB SAFETY CAMPUS CONSTRUCT

two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to plan, design and construct a public safety campus for the fire and police departments on the east mesa in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

SIERRA CO COMPLEX CONSTRUCT

six million dollars (\$6,000,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a county complex in Truth or Consequences in Sierra county
