AN ACT
RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL PERMITS FOR
HAY TRANSPORTATION; ELIMINATING DISTANCE LIMITS FOR HAY
TRANSPORTATION; RECONCILING MULTIPLE AMENDMENTS TO THE SAME
SECTION OF LAW IN LAWS 1995; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 66-7-413.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws
1985, Chapter 4, Section 1, as amended by Laws 1995,
Chapter 28, Section 1 and also by Laws 1995, Chapter 135,
Section 23) is amended to read:

"66-7-413.1. HAY TRANSPORTATION--EXCESSIVE SIZE--
SPECIAL PERMIT ALLOWANCE.--A vehicle used to transport loads
of hay greater than one hundred two inches wide may be issued
a special permit to transport loads pursuant to Section
66-7-413 NMSA 1978; provided that the vehicle is marked on
the front and the rear with "OVERSIZED LOAD" signs. The area
covered by the special permit shall be specified on the
permit."

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
peace, health and safety that this act take effect
immediately.
