AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR THE STATE FAIR COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.--This act may be cited as the "State Fair Commission Appropriation Act".

- SECTION 2. DEFINITION.--As used in the State Fair Commission Appropriation Act, "other state funds" means:
- A. unexpended balances in state agency accounts appropriated by the General Appropriation Act of 2012; and
- B. all revenue available to state agencies from sources other than the general fund and federal funds.
- SECTION 3. FORMAT.--The general format of the appropriations set forth in the State Fair Commission
