51ST LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2013

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT; PROHIBITING FALSE
STATEMENTS TO THE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING CRIMINAL PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Environmental Improvement
Act is enacted to read:

"~~[NEW MATERIAL]~~ FALSE STATEMENTS TO THE DEPARTMENT--
PENALTIES.--

A. No person regulated by the department shall:

(1) make a false statement or representation
to an employee of the department, whether oral, written or
visual;

(2) make a false statement, representation,
certification or omission of material fact in an application,
record, report, plan or other document filed with or submitted

1 to the department, or required by rule to be maintained by the
2 person regulated by the department;

3 (3) falsify, tamper with or render inaccurate
4 any device, method or record to be relied upon by the
5 department to monitor or track information;

6 (4) falsify or conceal a material fact; or

7 (5) make or use any document with the
8 knowledge that the document contains material false statements
9 or representations.

10 B. A person who knowingly violates or knowingly
11 causes or allows another person to violate Subsection A of this
12 section is guilty of a fourth degree felony and shall be
13 sentenced in accordance with the provisions of Section 31-18-15
14 NMSA 1978.

15 C. A person who is convicted of a second or
16 subsequent violation of Subsection A of this section is guilty
17 of a third degree felony and shall be sentenced in accordance
18 with the provisions of Section 31-18-15 NMSA 1978.

19 D. A person who knowingly violates Subsection A of
20 this section or knowingly causes or allows another person to
21 violate Subsection A of this section, and whose violation
22 results in an adverse environmental impact, is guilty of a
23 third degree felony and shall be sentenced in accordance with
24 the provisions of Section 31-18-15 NMSA 1978.

25 E. A person who knowingly violates Subsection A of

1 this section or knowingly causes or allows another person to
2 violate Subsection A of this section, and whose violation
3 creates a substantial danger of death or serious bodily injury
4 to another person, is guilty of a second degree felony and
5 shall be sentenced in accordance with the provisions of Section
6 31-18-15 NMSA 1978.

7 F. A person who negligently violates or negligently
8 causes or allows another person to violate Subsection A of this
9 section may be issued a compliance order pursuant to Section
10 74-1-10 NMSA 1978 with a penalty of up to ten thousand dollars
11 (\$10,000) and may be ordered to take any action the department
12 finds necessary to remediate the consequences of the person's
13 negligent violation. A monetary penalty shall not be assessed
14 under this subsection for a negligent violation that is
15 discovered by the person regulated by the department, provided
16 that the person immediately notifies the department of the
17 negligent violation in writing and agrees in writing to
18 promptly take any action the department finds necessary to
19 remediate the consequences of the negligent violation.

20 G. For the purposes of this section, "person
21 regulated by the department" means:

22 (1) an applicant for or holder of a liquid
23 waste permit issued or to be issued pursuant to the
24 Environmental Improvement Act and applicable rules;

25 (2) a person who owns a liquid waste system

1 subject to a permit requirement who has failed to obtain the
2 required permit;

3 (3) an owner or operator of a public water
4 system subject to the Environmental Improvement Act and
5 applicable rules; or

6 (4) an agent or other person acting on behalf
7 of any of the persons covered by Paragraphs (1) through (3) of
8 this subsection."
