AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES; AMENDING THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ACT TO ALLOW A PORTION OF LOCAL PROCEEDS TO BE USED FOR SALARIES OF CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 22-25-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1975 (S.S.), Chapter 5, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-25-2. DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Public School Capital Improvements Act:

A. "program unit" means the product of the program element multiplied by the applicable cost differential factor, as defined in Section 22-8-2 NMSA 1978; and

B. "capital improvements" means expenditures, including payments made with respect to lease-purchase

1 arrangements as defined in the Education Technology Equipment

20 Capital Improvements Act local mill levy;

21 (4) purchasing activity vehicles for
22 transporting students to extracurricular school activities; or

23 (5) purchasing computer software and hardware
24 for student use in public school classrooms."
