11 AMENDING THE DRIVING SCHOOL LICENSING ACT; REMOVING THE

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. Section 66-10-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
18 Chapter 185, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:

19 "66-10-4. QUALIFICATIONS OF DRIVER EDUCATION
20 INSTRUCTORS.--Every person in order to qualify as an instructor
21 for a driver education school shall meet the following
22 requirements:

23 A. possess qualifications as prescribed by the
24 bureau;

25 B. be physically able to operate safely a motor
