11	RELATING TO ALCOHOL; AMENDING AND ENACTING SECTIONS OF THE
12	LIQUOR CONTROL ACT TO PROVIDE FOR LIMITED HOTEL LICENSURE.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. A new section of the Liquor Control Act is
16	enacted to read:
17	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] LIMITED HOTEL LICENSEIn a local option
18	district that has voted to approve the sale of alcoholic
19	beverages, the director may issue a limited hotel license upon
20	application by a person qualified under the provisions of the
21	Liquor Control Act subject to the following requirements and
22	restrictions:
23	A. a limited hotel license shall be allowed to sell
24	beer and wine in opened containers for on-premises consumption
25	only except as provided for in Section 60-7B-13 NMSA 1978;

1 Β. the premises covered by a limited hotel license 2 shall include the entire hotel facility; a limited hotel license shall not be transferred 3 C. from person to person or from one location to another; 4 a limited hotel license shall expire annually 5 D. and be subject to renewal upon application to the director by 6 7 the licensee pursuant to Section 60-6B-5 NMSA 1978; sale, service and consumption of alcoholic 8 Ε. 9 beverages authorized in this section shall be permitted during the hours set forth in Section 60-7A-1 NMSA 1978; and 10 the provisions of Section 60-6A-18 NMSA 1978 F. 11 12 shall not apply to limited hotel licenses." SECTION 2. Section 60-6A-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1981, 13 14 Chapter 39, Section 32, as amended) is amended to read: "60-6A-15.
