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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. TECHNOLOGY RESEARCH COLLABORATIVE CREATED
16	PURPOSE
17	A. The "technology research collaborative" is
18	created. The New Mexico institute of mining and technology
19	shall be the fiscal agent for the collaborative.
20	B. Participating institutions associated with the
21	collaborative shall include national laboratories, other major
22	research institutes and all the post-secondary institutions of
23	New Mexico.
24	C. The purposes of the collaborative are to:
25	(1) establish advanced technology centers

Intellectual property created by an employee or 10 D. agent of an institution associated with the collaborative shall 11 12 be owned by that institution. Intellectual property created jointly shall be owned jointly. If the intellectual property 13 14 is created using federal funds, the applicable federal laws and regulations shall govern the ownership. 15 Ε. The collaborative may receive appropriations 16 from the legislature through the board of regents of the New 17 Mexico institute of mining and technology and may receive any 18 other items of value from public or private sources. 19 20 F. The "board of the technology research collaborative" is created. The board shall consist of eleven 21 members as follows: 22 the governor, or the governor's designee, (1) 23 who shall chair the collaborative; 24 the presidents, or their designees, of the 25 (2) .192936.1 - 2 -

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1 university of New Mexico, New Mexico state university and New 2 Mexico institute of mining and technology; five members at large, appointed by the 3 (3) governor with the consent of the senate; 4 the director of Sandia national 5 (4) laboratories, or the director's designee; and 6 7 (5) the director of Los Alamos national laboratory, or the director's designee. 8 9 G. Appointed members shall serve for two-year terms at the pleasure of the governor. Members serve until their 10 successors have been appointed. The governor may fill any 11 12 vacancy on the board for the remainder of an unexpired term. The board may elect officers as it deems н. 13 14 necessary to carry out its duties. A majority of the members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of 15 business, and the board shall meet four times per year. 16 Board members shall not vote by proxy. 17 Public members of the board shall receive per I. 18 19 diem and mileage pursuant to the Per Diem and Mileage Act and 20 shall receive no other compensation, perquisite or allowance. J. The board shall: 21 employ a director and other staff, who (1)22 shall be exempt from the provisions of the Personnel Act, as 23 the board deems necessary to provide continuity and management 24 of the collaborative; and 25 .192936.1 - 3 -
