SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 116 appropriates \$50 thousand from the general fund to the DMA for expenditure in FY14 to raise awareness of the USS New Mexico submarine. The bill will recognize the top sailors of the USS New Mexico crew each quarter, recognize the top sailor of the year, educate the people of New Mexico about the mission of the submarine, and sponsor visits of the crew to New Mexico. Unexpended funds will revert to the general fund at the end of FY14.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

House Bill 16 appropriates \$50 thousand to the DMA's operating budget from the general fund and the DMA will administer the funds for the Navy League.

WHAT WILL BE THE CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ENACTING THIS BILL

The people of New Mexico will not be aware of the Submarine USS New Mexico and the crews will not be able to visit the State of New Mexico.
