## SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of HTPWC Amendment

The House Transportation and Public Works Committee amendment to House Bill 582 inserts a new section in Section 66-7-327 NMSA 1978 that exempts individuals riding bicycles from giving arm and hand signals currently prescribed in the motor vehicle code.

#### Synopsis of Original Bill

House Bill 582 enacts a new section of Chapter 66, Article 3 NMSA 1978 to provide for a person operating a bicycle to use the right hand to signal a right turn.
