House Memorial 88 recognizes the many contributions of Dale Ball to Santa Fe and New Mexico and declares Thursday, March 7, 2013 as “Dale Ball Day” in the House of Representatives.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Dale and Sylvia Ball have been members of the Santa Fe community since 1981 and were named Santa Fe Living Treasures in 1999. Mr. Ball founded and became the first executive director of the Santa Fe Conservation Trust, a nonprofit land trust dedicated to preserving open spaces, traditional landscapes and foothill trails in greater Santa Fe.
