### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of HBIC Amendment

House Business and Industry Committee amendment to Senate Bill 154 changes the time for Sunday liquor sales to 11:00 AM.

#### Synopsis of Original Bill

Senate Bill 154 amends Section 60-7A-1 of the Liquor Control Act to allow Sunday Sales to begin at 10:00 am; two hours earlier than the noon starting time under the current statute. The bill also cleans up and moves some language from one section to another but does not change intent.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

RLD notes that any fiscal impact for the Alcohol and Gaming Division would be minimal. Permit applications are already being submitted and approved. No additional requirements are foreseen
