SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

On October 23, 2012 the Legislative Finance Committee Sunrise/Sunset Subcommittee reviewed presentation from the Regulation and Licensing Department superintendent J. Dee Dennis who described the Signed Language of Interpreting Practices Board services to the public. Generally, the subcommittee has the option of one of the three following recommendations for each board or commission: to continue with a new sunset date, to continue with the removal of the sunset date, or to terminate a board by allowing it to sunset. The subcommittee voted to extend the signed language interpreting practices board sunset date to July 1, 2018.
