Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 88 requests the Public Education Department (PED) to standardize a public school accountability report card and a school district accountability report card, and to provide accurate and timely data from those report cards in a statewide accountability report.

The memorial also requests that the PED post the up-to-date statewide accountability report card on its website. SM 88 requests that these report cards include 26 data variables as outlined in the memorial; including expenditure per student, the one-year dropout rate, the status of Title I program improvement, and family engagement.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Assuming the PED can standardize these report cards and the statewide report within its FY13 and FY14 operating budgets, there will be no fiscal impact on the State.
