21	WHEREAS, the institute of medicine report, "The Future Of
22	Nursing: Leading Change, Advancing Health", recommends that
23	nurses, including nurse-midwives, be full partners with
24	physicians and other health care professionals in redesigning

WHEREAS, the university of New Mexico nurse-midwifery education program has educated over one-third of the nurse-midwives working in New Mexico, and has one of three endowed chairs in nurse-midwifery research in the nation; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico affiliate of the American college of nurse-midwives represents nurse-midwives throughout the state;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that January 31, 2013 be declared "Nurse-Midwifery Day" in the house of representatives; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the New Mexico affiliate of the American college of nurse-midwives.
