Bill Summary:

HB 172 makes an appropriation for athletic programs at Mesalands Community College (MCC).

Fiscal Impact:

\$75,000 is appropriated from the General Fund to the Higher Education Department (HED) for expenditure in FY 15. Unexpended or unencumbered funds revert to the General Fund.

Fiscal Issues:

According to HED, this funding request was submitted by HED for review. HED recommended no increase in funding for this project. FY 14 appropriation for this program is \$59,900.

Substantive Issues:

The analysis of HB 172 by HED suggests that the appropriation would support the Mesalands Rodeo Team (MRT), which is among the top college rodeo teams in the United States.

Background:

HED states that MCC has hosted five annual community college rodeo competitions. MRT has won several championships and has set national records in this sport.
