Noting the universal need for a high-quality, well-rounded education, which includes consideration of a number of "wraparound issues," such as mental health, healthcare, meal programs, and technology, as well as acknowledging the systemic problem of poverty in New Mexico, SJM 11 asks the Legislature to:

- "renew its commitment to New Mexico's families, students, educators and communities to focus resources and create policies in a way that moves New Mexico towards its shared vision of universal, high-quality education."
