14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:		
15	SECTION 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is		
16	enacted to read:		
17	"[ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] TEXTING WHILE DRIVING		
18	A. A person shall not read or view a text message		
19	or type on a handheld mobile communication device for any		
20	purpose while driving a motor vehicle, except to summon medical		
21	or other emergency help.		
22	B. As used in this section:		
23	(1) "driving" means being in actual physical		
24	control of a motor vehicle on a highway or street and includes		
25	being temporarily stopped because of traffic or at a traffic		
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light, but "driving" excludes operating a motor vehicle when the vehicle has pulled over to the side of or off of an active roadway and has stopped at a location in which it can safely remain stationary;

"handheld mobile communication device" 5 (2)means a wireless communication device that is designed to 6 7 receive and transmit text or image messages, but "handheld 8 mobile communication device" excludes global positioning or 9 navigation systems, devices that are physically or electronically integrated into a motor vehicle and voice-10 operated or hands-free devices that allow the user to write, 11 12 send or read a text message without the use of a hand except to activate, deactivate or initiate a feature or function; and 13

(3) "text message" means a digital communication transmitted or intended to be transmitted between communication devices and includes electronic mail, an instant message, a text or image communication and a command or request to an internet site; but "text message" excludes communications through the use of a computer-aided dispatch service by law enforcement or rescue personnel."

SECTION 2. Section 66-8-116 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 524, as amended) is amended to read:

B. The term "penalty assessment misdemeanor" does not include a violation that has caused or contributed to the cause of an accident resulting in injury or death to a person.

C. When an alleged violator of a penalty assessment misdemeanor elects to accept a notice to appear in lieu of a notice of penalty assessment, a fine imposed upon later conviction shall not exceed the penalty assessment established for the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor and probation imposed upon a suspended or deferred sentence shall not exceed ninety days.

D. The penalty assessment for speeding in violation of Paragraph (4) of Subsection A of Section 66-7-301 NMSA 1978 is twice the penalty assessment established in Subsection A of this section for the equivalent miles per hour over the speed limit.

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1 Ε. Upon a second conviction for operation without a 2 permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Section 3 66-7-413 NMSA 1978, the penalty assessment shall be two hundred 4 fifty dollars (\$250). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, 5 the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500). Upon a second conviction for transport of a F. 6 7 reducible load with a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Subsection N of Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978 more 8 9 than six miles from a port-of-entry facility on the border with Mexico, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars 10 (\$500). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty 11 12 assessment shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000)."
