14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. Section 66-4-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,

18	DESTROYING OR DISMANTLING IN VIOLATION OF THE ACT
19	A. Any person violating any provision of Sections
20	[64-3-119 and 64-3-121, 64-3-123 through 64-3-125 and 64-4-1
21	through 64-4-9 NMSA 1953] 66-3-119, 66-3-121, 66-3-123 through
22	<u>66-3-125, 66-4-1.1 and 66-4-3 through 66-4-5 NMSA 1978</u> is
23	guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of
24	three hundred dollars (\$300) or by imprisonment for not less

1	conviction of [such offense shall be] <u>a violation of any</u>

4	B. A person who violates any provision of Sections
5	<u>66-4-1, 66-4-2, 66-4-2.2, 66-4-6 and 66-4-7 NMSA 1978 is guilty</u>
6	of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of one
7	thousand dollars (\$1,000) or by imprisonment for not less than
8	thirty days, or both. The penalty upon second conviction of a
9	violation of any provision of those sections is that provided
10	for a fourth degree felony or a fine of five thousand dollars
11	(\$5,000), or both. The penalty upon third or subsequent
12	conviction of a violation of any provision of those sections is
13	that provided for a second degree felony or a fine of ten
14	thousand dollars (\$10,000), or both, and the person's dealer
15	license shall be permanently revoked."
16	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
17	provisions of this act is July 1, 2014.
