WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the legislature, the public regulation commission and affected parties to consider whether New Mexico telecommunications statutes should be updated to reflect the changing telecommunications marketplace and advancing technologies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to direct the appropriate interim legislative committee to hear testimony and receive recommendations from the public regulation commission, the attorney general and
