SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 269 increases the probate court filing fee by \$5 to support the judicial educational fund.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The table above reflects an unknown fiscal impact. Because probate courts are county courts, data on number of case filings and fees collected is not tracked by the AOC.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The AOC notes that the additional revenue would allow the Judicial Education Center more resources to bring judicial education to all judges, regardless of their courts.
