### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Joint Memorial 16 requests that HED form a task force to study the representation of minorities in the faculties of social work, sociology, and psychology programs in New Mexico's higher education institutions. The memorial requests that the task force include representatives from the Office on African American Affairs, the National Hispanic Cultural Center, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored Peoples, the University of New Mexico Native American Studies Department, the All Indian Pueblo Council, the New Mexico Alliance for Hispanic Education, the Southwest Hispanic Research Institute, and a dean or department head and a faculty member from each school, college, or department of social work, sociology, and psychology. Finally, HJM 16 requests that the task force and HED report the results of the study to the appropriate interim legislative committee by August 1, 2014.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The memorial does not contain an appropriation. The requested study would be conducted with existing resources.
