SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Following a study commissioned by federal law in 2004, the National Park Service and the Department of Energy recommended establishment of a national historical park at three sites where a majority of the scientific activities associated with the Manhattan Project occurred, including Los Alamos. Two bills, Senate Bill 507 and House of Representatives Bill 1208, were introduced in Congress in January 2013 to establish such a park with the support and cosponsorship of New Mexico Senators Tom Udall and Mark Heinrich and Representatives Michelle Lujan Grisham and Ben Ray Lujan among others.
