Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 4 encourages the state's congressional delegation to advocate for making "Native American Heritage Day" a legal public holiday. This memorial recognizes Native Americans' historic and contemporary experiences and their substantial contributions to the United States' cultural, artistic, economic, social, religious, and political landscapes. The federal government established the fourth Friday of every year as "Native American Heritage Day." HM4 states that declaring this day as a legal public holiday would provide more opportunity to educate Americans and correct misunderstandings about indigenous cultures, and to celebrate Native Americans' contributions to the United States.
