Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 10 (HM 10) declares January 22, 2014, as “Coaches Versus Cancer and Suits and Sneakers Day” in the Senate.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

No fiscal impact.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

HM 10 notes that more than ten thousand New Mexicans were newly diagnosed with cancer in 2013 and due to their diagnoses face many physical, emotional, financial and day-to-day challenges.

The coaches versus cancer and suits and sneakers awareness nationwide effort unites coaches across the country to wear sneakers with their game attire while coaching games and encourages lawmakers and others to wear suits and sneakers to raise awareness about the fight against cancer.

Supporters raised more than \$87 million to help make the American cancer society’s services and programs available to those who need them most.
