C. "disability" means that the person has a 5 physical or mental disability that substantially limits one or 6 7 more of that person's functions, such as caring for oneself, 8 performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, 9 breathing, learning and working;

D. "homelessness" means that a person lacks a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence or has a primary nighttime residence that is:

(1) a place not designated for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; or (2) a publicly or privately operated shelter designed to provide temporary living accommodations;

 $[D_{\cdot}]$ <u>E</u>. "motivated by hate" means the commission of a crime with the intent to commit the crime because of the actual or perceived race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, age, [handicapped status] <u>disability, homelessness</u>, gender, sexual orientation or gender identity of the victim, whether or not the offender's belief or perception was correct; and

[E.] F. "sexual orientation" means heterosexuality, homosexuality or bisexuality, whether actual or perceived."
