1 Α. It is unlawful for a person to organize, cause, 2 sponsor, arrange, hold or participate in a coyote-killing 3 contest. As used in this section, "coyote-killing 4 Β. contest" means an organized or sponsored competition with the 5 objective of killing coyotes for prizes or entertainment. 6 7 C. Organizing, causing, sponsoring, arranging or holding a coyote-killing contest consists of a person: 8 9 (1) knowingly planning, organizing or enticing a person to participate in a coyote-killing contest; or 10 (2) knowingly providing the venue for a 11 12 coyote-killing contest. D. Participation in a coyote-killing contest 13 14 consists of a person knowingly taking part in a coyote-killing contest. 15 E. A person who organizes, causes, sponsors, 16 arranges or holds a coyote-killing contest is guilty of a 17 18 misdemeanor. A person who participates in a coyote-killing 19 F. 20 contest is guilty of a petty misdemeanor. Nothing in this section shall be construed to G. 21 prohibit a person from protecting a person or property, unless 22 otherwise prohibited by law." 23 SECTION 3.
