thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to plan, design and construct repairs and improvements to the water supply system for the Cumbres and Toltec scenic railroad water tank in Sublette in Rio Arriba county

nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000) to plan, design, renovate and construct the natatorium for the Jal public school district in Lea county
