WHEREAS, Major Butler then enlisted in the United States army special forces as a green beret and served in that position for the remainder of his military career; and

WHEREAS, Major Butler completed the army's physician assistant program and received a bachelor's degree from the university of Nebraska and a master's degree from the university of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, Major Butler served in an elite unit as a medic and weapons specialist; and

WHEREAS, Major Butler served in most of the conflicts that have made recent headline history, including Panama, Honduras, Somalia, Iraq and Afghanistan, and completed fortyfour combined missions in Iraq and Afghanistan; and
