

1 A MEMORIAL

2 DECLARING JANUARY 29, 2015 "SANTA FE COUNTY DAY" IN THE  
3 SENATE.

5 WHEREAS, in 1852, Santa Fe county was established as  
6 one of the first counties in the United States territory of  
7 New Mexico; and

8 WHEREAS, Santa Fe county has within its boundaries the  
9 local government jurisdictions of the city of Espanola, the  
10 city of Santa Fe and the town of Edgewood; and

11 WHEREAS, Santa Fe county has within its boundaries the  
12 tribal government jurisdictions of the Pueblo of Santa  
13 Clara, the Pueblo of San Ildefonso, the Pueblo of Nambe, the  
14 Pueblo of Pojoaque, the Pueblo of Tesuque, the Pueblo of  
15 Cochiti and the Pueblo of Santo Domingo; and

16 WHEREAS, Santa Fe county also encompasses many  
17 long-inhabited traditional communities; and

18 WHEREAS, county residents are governed by publicly  
19 elected officials on the board of county commissioners, the  
20 county clerk, the county assessor, the county treasurer, the  
21 county probate judge and the county sheriff; and

22 WHEREAS, the great variety of cultures and traditions  
23 represented in Santa Fe county has created a vibrant and  
24 unique community; and

25 WHEREAS, Santa Fe county honors and promotes the strong

1 traditions and culture of the indigenous people of  
2 New Mexico, the Hispanic people of New Mexico and the Anglo  
3 people of New Mexico;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE  
5 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that Santa Fe county residents, past and  
6 present, be recognized for their contributions in creating  
7 an inclusive environment honoring the county's diverse  
8 cultures and traditions; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that January 29, 2015 be  
10 declared "Santa Fe County Day" in the senate; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be  
12 transmitted to the mayor of the city of Espanola, the mayor  
13 of the city of Santa Fe, the mayor of the town of Edgewood  
14 and the governors of the Pueblo of Santa Clara, the Pueblo  
15 of  
16 San Ildefonso, the Pueblo of Nambe, the Pueblo of Pojoaque,  
17 the Pueblo of Tesuque, the Pueblo of Cochiti and the Pueblo
