

1 A MEMORIAL

2 DECLARING FEBRUARY 11, 2015 "MOLINA DAY" IN THE SENATE.

4 WHEREAS, Molina healthcare was founded thirty years ago
5 by Dr. C. David Molina, an emergency room physician who
6 opened a medical clinic to serve the patients he frequently
7 treated in the emergency room simply because they did not
8 have a primary care doctor to care for them; and

9 WHEREAS, from that clinic, Molina healthcare continued
10 to grow over the next three decades to become a fortune 500,
11 multistate health care organization that provides
12 government-sponsored health care programs; and

13 WHEREAS, the company has evolved over the years, but
14 the mission has remained the same: to provide those most in
15 need with access to high-quality health care programs; and

16 WHEREAS, this mission is still carried out today by the
17 founder's children, Dr. J. Mario Molina, president and chief
18 executive officer; John C. Molina, chief financial officer;
19 and Dr. Martha Molina Bernadett, executive vice president;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, Patty Kehoe is the president of Molina
22 healthcare of New Mexico's subsidiary and was promoted to
23 her current position in January 2013; and

24 WHEREAS, Molina healthcare of New Mexico serves
25 approximately two hundred seven thousand New Mexicans, and

1 it recently opened clinics in Santa Fe and Albuquerque; and

2 WHEREAS, the Molina healthcare of New Mexico network
3 comprises approximately one thousand five hundred primary
4 care physicians and six thousand five hundred specialists
5 and is affiliated with approximately seventy hospitals in
6 New Mexico; and

7 WHEREAS, Molina healthcare of New Mexico is ranked the
8 number one medicaid health plan in New Mexico;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
10 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 11, 2015 be declared
11 "Molina Day" in the senate; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
13 transmitted to Molina healthcare of New Mexico.
