SUMMARY

HB 498 would remove local authority to enact a minimum wage that is higher than the state minimum wage, and would allow the state to preempt any type of employee leave from employment.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

No fiscal impacts. See, "significant issues."

SIGNIFCANT ISSUES

The Economic Development Department (EDD) reports that although restricting the minimum wage to the state level may improve the regulatory environment, it is "appropriate that minimum wage laws be dealt with at the local level, not the state. This has been the position of EDD for many years."
